Listed below are the various ways in which you can help.

- Plan worship/participate in leading worship at Bethesda.
- Attend worship and visit with residents following the service.
- Community work projects: mowing, tree trimming, maintenance on guttering, dog run, etc.
- Plan and make frozen meals for food pantry clients.
- Plan and prepare noon meal for congregation following projects.
- Participate in a community prayer walk in Goessel.
- Embroider tea towels for the MCC sale.
- For children, with adult volunteers to coordinate and help:
 - Make cards for residents at Bethesda.*
 - Make cards for food pantry clients.*
 - Childcare and other activities.*

Items for everyone to bring:

- lawn chairs and table service for any meal you participate in throughout the weekend.

In conjunction with Service Sunday, the Tabor Fellowship Planning Team invites anyone interested to come fellowship and camp in the park on Saturday evening, September 15. We plan to have the fire going around 5:30pm, so feel free to bring food (e.g. hot dogs) to roast for supper and we will also provide S'more fixings for dessert. We will provide some lawn games, but invite you to bring more. If you camp overnight, or want to come to church early on Sunday (8am), please also bring breakfast foods.
